

**MODERN SLAVERY ACT STATEMENT

**Our Business**

We work with a number of suppliers to turn your cherished photographs into beautiful, personal keepsakes and gifts.

**Our Policies**

We do not currently have any internal policies pertaining to combatting modern slavery and human trafficking. However, we will pursue corrective action in the event we uncover employee or supplier compliance problems.

**Our Suppliers**

We do not currently conduct assessments of our product suppliers or subcontractors to see if they may be at risk for violating anti-slavery and human trafficking laws. However, if we learn that a supplier is violating such laws, we will terminate that supplier.

**Training**

We do not currently provide employees or contractors with training on human trafficking and slavery.

**Our Performance Indicators**

Information indicating that slavery and/or human trafficking problems may exist within our business or supply chain would be received by us through internal and external reports of issues. Potential sources of such information include employees, the public, and law enforcement.
